

RECREATION PLANNING BOARD MEETING MINUTES PORTER TOWNSHIP

JULY 11, 2016 8:00PM

Attendance: Kevin Frank, Mike Champion, Rich Brungard, Carol Colucci, Mark Saville and Nancy Chavka

The meeting was called to order at 8:35PM following the Supervisors meeting. The minutes from the May meeting were reviewed and approved. On a 1st motion by Champion and a 2nd by Frank motion passed to accept the minutes as presented. There was no June meeting.

The old business is an update review on the completion of volleyball pit. The net needs adjustments to be tighter. We can wait until its taken down for the season. 6ft Benches have been installed on the trail. A new childs digger was purchased and installed. There is a childs T-swing that was also purchased at the same time from Play World. No cost on freight Rich picked up in Lewisburg. The swing will be installed this week. Glossener Concrete is donating the cement for installing the frame post.

A message board has been installed and things have been posted inside. The Clinton County Landfill donated 10 yards of mulch and we purchased 30 yards totaling 40 yards used.

New Business was discussing the trail has settled and areas in the park needs to be cleaned up. Rich addressed he needs to have equipment of some sort to haul stones/dirt around to maintain the trail. Supervisor Kevin stated as long as Rich is an employee of the Township he will donate his kabota ATV for Rich to use at the park.

Five new six foot picnic tables were purchased on sale at Lowes for \$98.00 each. These will be placed throughout the park outside of the pavilions. Rich will seal coat them before their put out. Kevin reported that in the far corner of the park a 4" pipe is needed to eliminate a wash out on the one spot. That needs to be taken care of.


Chairman Kevin proposed for the park to schedule a public awareness day / community day for the trail opening and improvements that have been done to the park.

Nancy Chavka read a list of ideas proposed possibilities for a special day. Kevin proposed promoting a safety day. A presentation by Gessinger's Life Flight and having the helicopter in the baseball field, State Police seat belt safety.

Nancy proposed asking Millers Gun Shop for gun safety, Fish and Boat Commission, Penn Dot, fitness awareness and other gun safety for women on hand guns with permit to carry. After discussing possibilities to schedule a date the board came to an agreement to wait until spring 2017 due to much conflict in setting a date.
