

**SUPERVISORS PUBLIC HEARING MEETING MINUTES
FLOOD ORDINANCE**

JUNE 14TH 2016 TOWNSHIP BUILDING 7:00 PM

Attendance: Chairman Kevin Frank, Larry Dotterer, Mike Champion, Secretary Carol Colucci, Zoning Officer Rich Brungard, Solicitor O'Connor and 1 member of the public.

The meeting was called to order by Supervisor Chairman Kevin Frank at 9:07AM. Supervisor Frank stated this was a public hearing for the adoption of the Flood Ordinance. He then turned the meeting over to Solicitor O'Connor.

Bob O'Connor reported the ordinance must be adopted and submitted to FEMA in Harrisburg by June 16th 2016 for the Township to be eligible for FEMA Insurance. He explained the process and that as a result of the State not adopting the 2015 budget in a timely manner, the subcontractor for DCED was furloughed for several months which has now made the window for the adoption of new floodplain regulations very small.

A Resolution is needed to designate a Flood Ordinance Administrator. On a 1st motion by Frank and a 2nd by Dotterer motion passed to appoint Rich Brungard the Zoning Officer to be the Flood Ordinance Administrator Resolution #6-2016-14.

Supervisor Champion inquired if the Flood Ordinance can be amended after it is adopted? O'Connor replied yes it can be amended. He recommends the ordinance to be reviewed by the township engineer for any recommendations he may have due to the differences of flood fringe, flood way, flood plain.

On a 1st motion by Champion and a 2nd by Dotterer motion passed to adopt the Flood Ordinance #6-2016-14

There were no public comments. Terry Jeirles was the only resident attending.

Zoning Officer Brungard reported there has been a letter received from DEP for a possible sewage violation. Rich has checked into the site and SEO Stan Wallace will be looking at the property.

Brungard also reported to the Supervisors that the Dan Auman property now has more violations with pigs on his property R-1 residential not zoned for pigs. The discussion was made for Solicitor O'Connor to send 2 separate violation warnings. One for the pigs and one for the junk on the property and within the floodplain.

After discussing if the violation should be sent registered mail or delivered by a constable the final discussion was to have the violation letters be delivered to Auman by a constable prepared by O'Connor.

A quote was given for a new exterior office door. S.A.M Construction gave a quote of \$1,847.45 to replace the exterior. The Supervisors agreed for Rich to get 2 more quotes before making a decision.

There was a short discussion on the Clinton County Sewer Authority Plan update Project. O'Connor advised to hold any decisions for now. Also the East Nittany Valley Joint Municipal Authority design plans were discussed about needing revised for many issues.

On a 1st motion by Dotterer and a 2nd by Champion motion passed to adjourn 10:10AM.
