

**RECREATION PLANNING BOARD MEETING MINUTES PORTER TOWNSHIP
MAY 2ND, 2016 8:00PM**

Attendance: Kevin Frank, Mike Champion, Rich Brungard, Carol Colucci and Mark Saville

The meeting was called to order at 8:20PM following the supervisors meeting. The minutes from the April meeting were reviewed and approved. On a 1st motion by Champion and a 2nd by Brungard motion passed to accept the minutes as presented.

Old business is an update on the Volleyball pit. Rich reported the net must be adjusted to fit the distance of the post. It is the wrong size. Rich will check with Stoltzfus Upholstery.

The 3 signs for the walking trail were revised wording and installed and looks good. Follow up on the quote from Nittany Woodcrafts for 6ft wooden benches was \$63. each plus water sealer. All agreed to order 3 to place spaced out on the trail.

The new childs T-swing and digger from Playworld is finished and ready for pick up. Rich is picking up in Lewisburg to save on shipping. A total of \$1,859.40.

The new business is the message board ordered from (PCI , Correctional Industries) Rockview will be delivered this week. Rich will install on restroom wall side facing handicap parking space. Kevin stated the ball team plans to pay for the memo board. There was discussion on what to post in it. It was suggested to place a thank you to those who helped make it possible for park improvements.

Rich reported he is waiting on a quote from Nittany Woodcrafts for the roof covered kiosk tables to be placed throughout park.


Glosseners concrete agreed to donate cement for installing the post for the new Toddler-swing. Mulch is needed every year under the swings. Clinton County Landfill stated they can donate 10 yards of mulch free to the township. Total of 40 yards needed.

There was a discussion about horse manure being in the park. It was suggested if it continues the Supervisors need to talk to the Bishop. There are signs posted NO pets or vehicles in the park. Kevin reported he has plans to schedule a community day at the park celebrating the opening of the walking trail and improvements. He suggested to wait until after the parade possibly July.

On a 1st motion by Champion and a 2nd by Frank motion passed to adjourn 8:57PM.
