Exhibit A, which I will move for admission into -- or which I will offer into admission into the record, is a notice which was published in the Express on the 28th of February, 2022, summarizing the Ordinance, advertising tonight's hearing and the proposed adoption, and indicating that a copy of the Ordinance is available here at the Township Building, a copy was available at the Clinton County Law Library, which I deposited there, and a copy available in my law offices.

Exhibit B is a copy of a response submitted by the Porter Township Planning Commission with respect to the proposed Ordinance, which the Planning Commission went through in detail at a previous work session. And the summary of their comments is in as Exhibit B.

Exhibit C is a copy of comments provided by the Clinton County Planning Commission dated February 18, 2022, which were provided to us and the Township Supervisors. And Exhibit D is a copy of the proposed Ordinance, itself.

And so at this point, I guess I will move the admission of Exhibits A, B, C, and D into the record that comply with the statutory requirements to amend the zoning ordinance. Is there any -- I guess, is there any objection to that from anyone?
